The intern will work on the KLA Community Dashboard – a web-based Software as a Service (SaaS) product used by local governments. (Here is an [example](#).) Community Dashboards are used to communicate progress on local government climate action plans and inspire action through an interactive, visual platform. The internship is an opportunity to work with an established start-up in the sustainability/climate change/clean energy space on a range of tasks that support the building and maintenance of community dashboards. Additionally, this position will work closely with the Dashboard product owner to assist with user interface/user experience (UI/UX) testing and improvements. Interns will have the chance to contribute to climate action initiatives for communities nationwide. The internship is 100% remote.

- Quality Assurance / Quality Checking:
 - Looking for spelling and grammar errors
 - Resolving bad links and glitches
- Helping improve the dashboard product:
 - Product testing
 - UI/UX testing, research, and recommendations
 - Creating internal or external reports or guides

- Performing market research

Qualifications

- Graduate students preferred; otherwise, must be a junior or senior pursuing a bachelor's degree
- Motivated, self-starter – must be comfortable in a fast-paced startup environment
- Must have strong time management skills
- Must have strong written and verbal communication skills
- Strong attention to detail and critical thinking skills
- Comfortable working in a team environment, receiving feedback, frequently checking in
- Proficiency in the essential Microsoft Office tools; Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and SharePoint
